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#### **SWEEPSTAKES**

The Shetland Sheepdog Club of Austin Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all breeders and owners of Shetland Sheepdogs. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the regular classes. Entry fee shall be \$6.00 for each puppy and entries shall be made in the space marked "Additional Classes" on the premium list by writing "Sweepstakes" and "6-9, 9-12 or 12-18". All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class at the regular fee.

#### **Distribution of Sweepstakes Prize Money**

35% of the total entry fee for the sweepstakes shall be reserved for expenses. 10% of the remaining entry fee shall be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes. The balance shall be divided as follows according to the number of entries in each individual class.
